

San Antonio Citizens Federal Credit Union Scholarship Terms and Conditions

Eligibility:

1. The applicant must be a primary member in good standing at San Antonio Citizens Federal Credit Union. For membership information click <https://www.sacfcu.org/become-a-member/>
2. The applicant must be a senior in high school who will enroll in an undergraduate course of study during the 2019-2020 academic school year at an accredited 2-year or 4-year college, university, vocational, technical or trade school in the United States.

Application:

1. The Online Scholarship Application must be completed and submitted along with the additional required documents by midnight Sunday, April 7, 2019 to be considered for the scholarship.
2. All information provided will remain confidential. No materials will be returned.

Selection:

1. Completed applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee.
2. Finalists may be asked to meet with the Scholarship Committee for an informal interview.
3. Recipients of the scholarship will be notified by Friday, May 31, 2019.
4. All decisions concerning the scholarship award will be the responsibility of the Scholarship Committee, and all decisions of the Scholarship Committee are final.

Payment:

1. Scholarship recipients will receive the funds deposited directly into their SACFCU account once their required documentation is submitted and approved, half for the first school term and half for the second.
2. Recipients of scholarship must provide San Antonio Citizens FCU proof of enrollment at the intended school named on the application, such proof would be a course schedule, receipt from registrar's office etc.
3. Scholarship is a non-recurring award.
4. Scholarship deposits may be postponed for a maximum of 1 year under extenuating circumstances. At that time, failure to provide needed documentation will result in cancellation of funding.
